**Budget and Finance:** Eduardo Sinz, Chair (787) 225-9251

- Prepare and supervise the annual giving campaign;
- Prepare and administer the annual church budget as approved by Council and congregation, administer the congregation's commitments, offerings, and gifts.

**Christian Education:** Dawn Román, Chair (787) 433-4771

- Provides Sunday School experience for all children and youth; also oversees annual summer Vacation Bible School, and other activities for children. Teachers and leaders are needed.
- UCSJ Youth Ministry is provided for senior and junior high school students, and features worship and Bible study participation, servant events, and other gatherings for spiritual growth and fellowship.

- Provides opportunities for congregation members to get to know one another and develop relationships necessary for strong Christian community life.
- Coordinate activities to this effect.
- Be responsible for the fellowship/hospital gathering on the patio immediately following the Sunday worship service.

- Help visitors, guests, new members, and inactive members, to be involved in the life of the church.
- Assist the Pastor in helping members of the congregation who have specific needs, and to provide person-to-person care to those in need.

- Provide suitable maintenance, care, cleaning, upkeep, and repair for all church owned facilities.
